

**Fight the Famine! Donations needed. Please help.**

Bridgehampton School students are among the volunteer youth groups on the East End leading the charge to put on a family-friendly fund-raiser on **Saturday, April 29th**, from **5 to 8 p.m.** at the Bridgehampton Community House on Main Street. Kids from Montauk to Shelter Island are involved. The money is going to **UNICEF**, which is urgently requesting help to feed the starving in Yemen, Nigeria, South Sudan, and Somalia. Nearly 1.4 million children are in danger of dying from hunger this year in those countries. We need your help.

**We Need Donations of fabric, please.** Some local artists will be working with volunteer students to create artwork to use as decorations at the fund-raiser; the kids will learn about the countries effected by making the national trees, birds, flowers, and flags of those nations from recycled fabric and found object. (The dates of the get-together at which these artworks will be created are April 8 and April 9th, at locations to be announced soon, one day in Montauk and the other in Bridgehampton. We will keep you posted, and all will be invited.)
