### College and Career Readiness Update:

#### Meeting Notes:

Our group discussed two goals:

Jeff Neubauer announced that Paddlers had again donated money to Bridgehampton School. At least \$10,000 of these funds will be dedicated to the Sprouts Farm Stand Project. Jeff and Judiann will meet on Monday, October 24<sup>th</sup> to draw up a budget and then will meet with the Sprouts group to discuss. Jeff and Judiann will also meet with Robert Hauser to discuss projected expenses and school/club financial responsibilities.

Vanessa spoke to Mike Miller/Dr. Favre about the Retreat presentation on Consent. Mike Miller was going to review presentation with Dr. Favre to see if it required Board of Ed review. Next steps will be discussed once review is finalized.

Vanessa and I discussed the *Beyond the Hive* Assembly, which we would like to hold the morning of the Holiday Luncheon. This is a time when most graduates are home for the holidays. We would like to get approval for the assembly from Dr. Favre and fill out the appropriate forms.

The assembly would follow the format of the previous one with students in grades 9-12 (possibly 8-12) cycling through four different 15 minute sessions with graduate students who:

1. Are still in college
2. Are in graduate school
3. Are in the workforce
4. Who went to a community college or tech school and then went directly into the workforce.
