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Minutes: Brief summary of meeting

No formal meeting was held for November due to aimsweb testing completion. The new Aimsweb Plus Fall Benchmarking K-8 testing in ELA and Mathematics is now completed. In the months of September and October the Data team attended 2 Aimsweb plus user/training meetings where they learned how to administer, score and understand reporting. The data/RTI/IST teams have been meeting to discuss data, assessments and achievement. Teachers are now able to view their class results. The data team also learned from representatives from Aimsweb and from ESBOCES that the new Aimsweb plus benchmarking program has not been approved as an assessment for APPR in New York. As a result the district decided to use NYS Regents scores as a part of APPR.

The special education teachers met with Mrs. Rodgers to review the Survey Level Assessment component of Aimsweb plus that allows teachers to benchmark and progress monitor students off of their grade level. This measure will give us a clear idea of student's skill level in ELA and Mathematics.

The IST has agreed upon Aimsweb training dates to be held November 29th for grades k-2 and December 1st for grades 3-5 at 2pm. This training will be given by Aleta Parker and Jessica Rodgers. Teachers are also learning how to run and print Aimsweb plus reports for their classes; this will allow them access to the standards based results for each student in their class printed as a student skills plan for each standard.

The data team has reviewed past NYS Mathematics Exam results and past Aimsweb benchmarking results for grades 3-5. The data team has also reviewed this Falls Aimsweb math results and found that 52% of students in grade 4 fell in the below average ranges. 41% of students in grade 5 fell below the national average ranges
