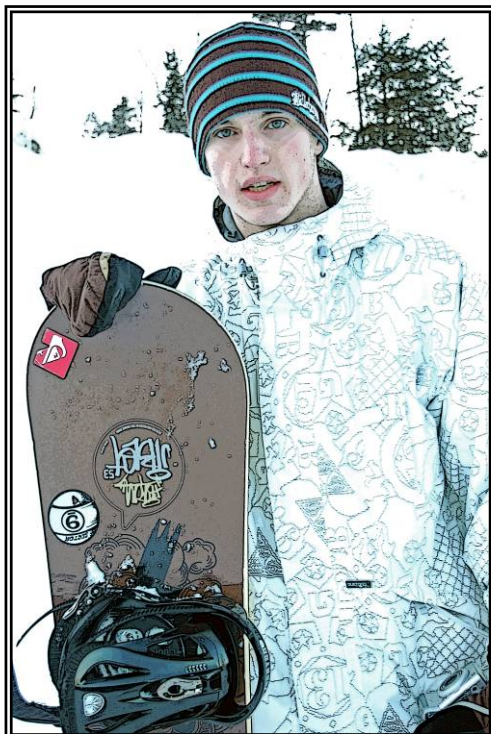




The Pancake Breakfast
